# How Much Federal Student Aid Can A Student Get?

In general, it depends on the student financial need. Financial need is determined by the Student Aid Index (SAI) and Cost of Attendance (COA)

SAI comes from what is reported on FAFSA

The

COA for college that the student will attend includes tuition, fees, housing and food, transportation, etc.

COA-SAI=financial need

#### How to Apply for Financial Aid

Create a studentaid.gov account username and password at <u>studentaid.gov</u> Students must first complete their Free Application For Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) at <u>studentaid.gov</u>

Students must include our school code on the FAFSA (0123456) If the student's parent is going to be a contributor, the student and the parent must each create a separate studentaid.gov account. Accounts cannot be shared.
