Changes from 2021-2022:

- Room & Board: Increased by 5.4% to reflect consumer price index inflation

- Dependent Care: Increased by 5.4% to reflect consumer price index inflation

Notes:

- LASFAA adopts these standard budgets and recommends their use by all undergraduate and proprietary schools. Professional schools and schools with special cases should consider utilizing higher budgets as needed. Professional judgements are also an option with appropriate documentation.
- These budgets are based on nine months.
- Federal student loan fees should be added to the student’s cost of attendance by each institution.
- A reasonable allowance for the documented rental or purchase of a personal computer can be included in the cost of attendance.
- No significant increase was determined to be present for books.
